

# **Course Delivery Options**



The NSW SPC has huge flexibility in how and when we deliver our professional learning

The need to generate profit is not a motive for what we develop or deliver.

"Viability" is determined by whether or not there are sufficient numbers for the course to be effective.

Costs can be very low if you provide the venue and catering.

## **Examples of what some schools have already done.**

#### Example 1

A school requested delivery of "The Next Step". The course was run on one day in the school's common room. They invited interested staff from their neighbouring schools and had a group of over 20 people. They negotiated a set fee with the SPC for the day. The school sorted catering. The cost per participant for the full day worked out at under \$100 per person.

### Example 2

A school wanted to provide some impetus for the regional DP network. They requested our DP Network presentation, provided the venue at the school, and coordinated afternoon tea. This 2-hour workshop was provided by SPC at no cost. The presentation included awareness raising of SPC PL options. Following this, the interest in the Principal well-being course was so high, that the school coordinated the delivery of the SPC program. The school sorted the venue and catering and negotiated a set fee with the SPC for delivery of the program.

#### Example 3

This example is currently in the planning stage. A rural network wants to increase the exposure of staff across its schools to high quality face to face professional learning from the SPC. They are considering running "The Next Step" (twice) and "Focus" across a consecutive 4-day period. Different people would be attending each course, but at the same venue, coordinated by the DEL. The SPC will provide the facilitator and deliver the entire program at a set fee. Consideration is also being given to running one of the courses on the Saturday.

The bottom line is that we have enormous flexibility, don't need to generate huge amounts of money and are driven by a desire to do what we can to support our schools. If you have a crazy idea, run it past us!
